Description

The working team composed of all project partners, following the input of CAT lead beneficiary of this WP, defined common lines for the realization of the planned objectives during two international meetings:

- Bologna, 10-11th june 2022
- online, 27th September 2022

The objectives were: the establishment of a group of young Roma and non-Roma leaders in each area involved by the project and the organization of a training focused on Roma history connected to European history (10h at least for each group).

The activities took place in 6 areas: 3 areas in Italy (Bologna-Modena, Florence, Naples), 1 in Poland (Krakow) and 2 in Portugal (Braga and Figueira da Foz). The following table shows the groups and the training activities carried out from July 2022 to March 2023 by each group.

Events and activities in Bologna

The group, composed of 7 young Roma and 1 non-Roma, is very interested in historical issues and the possibility of doing action-research with a group of peers. The University of Bologna has taken and is taking active steps to find out whether among its own students (or among those from nearby universities) there are other young people interested in joining the group so as to ensure greater heterogeneity in the group of young leaders. Team-building activities have been proposed to the group since it was set up (November 2022) to promote knowledge among the young people and the exchange of experiences. The aims of the Tracer project and its main stages were then explained. In January 2023, in-depth discussions on the history of the Roma people and European history were organized with the involvement and participation of Prof. Luca Bravi of the University of Florence.



Events and activities in Florence

CAT formed in June the group and the young leaders. The group is made up of 8 young people (5 roma and 3 not roma; 6 females and 2 males). All the young people involved have artistic and motivational skills or interests such as to ensure their constant presence and involvement in the project. In the first phase team building it was necessary to motivate the young leaders to participate in the activities continuously. Later the Cooperative CAT could organize a training on the meaning of the project and elements of European history. The young leaders involved showed great interest both in the historical themes proposed and in the artistic ones. The constitution of a work group, containing Roma people, is also determined by the relationships that the individual Roma communities have built over time with the majority community. CAT have tried to involve the young people most interested in the topic and with significant interpersonal skills.

The training planned at the beginning of July 2022 was shared with the University of Bologna and then sent to the other partners so that it could be an example and a way of working with local leader's groups.

Events and activities in Naples

The APS "chi rom e...chi no", in a first phase focused the activity on identifying the group of adolescents and young people, Roma and non-Roma to be involved in the project. It decided to aim for a mixed composition, in order to allow both the participation of Roma and non-Roma adolescents and young people from Scampia (northern area of Naples), and the involvement of young Roma from other contexts, including young Roma who are already nationally oriented and committed to the enhancement and protection of Roman culture and history, with the greatest attention to encouraging the inclusion of young women. From June to December 2022, meetings were held with a small group of 8 young people between the ages of 17 and 22. The meetings were accompanied by educators, social workers, and experts in the field, using the method of action-research, cooperative learning, and learning by doing, through the projection of audiovisual materials on the subject of the Holocaust and the Samudaripen and in-depth thematic discussions with circular debate.

Events and activities in Krakow

Stowarzyszenie Romow w Polsce during summer 2022 create a group of 8 leaders rom and non rom (6 Roma and 2 non Roma) who will work together during the activities of Tracer project. The meeting of the group leaders took place in Oświęcim from 1 to 3 August 2022. The first day the group took part in memorial ceremonies at the site of the former Auschwitz-Birkenau concentration camp at crematorium V. The group was shown what happened at the site of the former "Zigeunerlager" camp on the night of 1 to 2 August. The general concept and idea of Tracer project was then presented to the group of leaders explaining what the project is about, the objectives and the requirements for participation. On the 2nd august the group took part in the ceremony commemorating the liquidation of "ZIgeunerlager" at the grounds of the Auschwitz-Birkenau State Museum - the aim was to make the group of leaders aware of the scale of the holocaust that took place in Auschwitz-Birkenau. After the ceremony, the group of leaders was shown the permanent exhibition "Roma History and Culture" by a guide, with the aim of familiarizing the leaders with the history of European Roma from the time of their exodus from the Indian subcontinent to the present day. The main emphasis of the tour was to draw attention to the plight of the Roma on their journey from their arrival in Europe, the Holocaust, the communist period and how this affected Roma culture. In the third day of work the activities took place at the Roma Association in Poland where the Tracer project was discussed step by step and each leader proposed some activities to undertake during Tracer project.



Events and activities in Braga and Figueira de Foz

ACM and RIBALTAMBICAO formed the 2 groups of young leaders after a project presentation at the international seminar "Public Policies, scientific Knowledge and Roma civic participation" that took place at the University of Minho in December 2022.

The group of Braga is made up of 8 young people (4 females and 4 males, 6 Roma and 2 not Roma). The other group in Figueira da Foz is composed by 7 young people (3 females and 4 males, 6 Roma and 1 not Roma).

In february 2023 they planned the training to explain the role of young people in the project and their importance as leaders. Young people learned what is intended with the research of documentary sources on the holocaust and how bibliographic research is carried out and then they were introduced on the History of the Roma people also deeping the role played by Art in awareness and social transformation.
