Structuring a workshop in the classroom, sharing thematic inputs with teachers, sharing materials, describing indicators for evaluating an educational project 30/11/2024 (3 hours): Teaching Porrajimos. Re-elaboration of the materials developed by the teachers and design of the workshops to be taken to classes. 26/01/2024 (2 hours): Presentation of the project objectives to other teachers in the school so that class coordinators can introduce the topic to classes visiting the Porrajmos exhibition. Chi rom e chi no (Italy - Naples)	28/11/2023 (6 hours): Seminar: Roma people, a European story (at the Auditorium of "Galileo Ferraris" Secondary School - Naples) 12/01/2024 (4 hours): Training day on the history of the Roma community in Italy, with theoretical and practical insights into the issue of stereotyping (at Chikù – Naples)	17 participants

Stowarzyszenie Romow W Polsce (Poland – Krakow)	29/08/2023 (6 hours): History of the Holocaust, Holocaust education and developing empathy and tolerance 30/08/2023 (4 hours): Integrating Holocaust Education into the Curriculum The training was held at the Association Stowarzyszenie Romow W Polsce (Oswiecim)	10 participants
ACM/AIMA and University of Minho (Portugal – Braga)	13/06/2024 and 20/06/2024 (10 hours) Training was provided to teachers and technicians (social worker, psychologists and social educators). It took place at school and covered Roma history and culture, the Holocaust/Samaduripen and discrimination. The importance of raising student awareness of this reality was also reflected, in addition to those who participated in the TRACER project activities, drawing attention to the introduction of this themes in the discipline of history and citizenship. The evaluation of teachers and technicians was very positive, with teachers considering that it would be important to continue this training in the next academic year	18 participants
RIBALTAMBICAO (Portugal - Figueira da Foz)	06/02/2024, 20/02/2024: the invisible Roma Holocaust Two training sessions for teachers on Roma History and culture (total 10 hours) were held at the Figueira da Foz Vocational School, focusing on the invisible Roma holocaust. The lack of knowledge about Roma history and culture and even more about the invisible holocaust became apparent. The training sessions created a lot of debate, although prejudice and the crystallization of prejudices is visible among education agents.	11 participants
