
The objective of each group/partner was to organize a face to face training on Holocaust, History and Remembrance with the involvement of the young leaders' groups.


The training covered the topics of the genocide and the Roma Holocaust (Porrajmos), the relevance of remembering history in relation to regimes, repression and the importance of resistance. It was addressed to young students/adolescents in schools and daycare/residential care centres.
