## Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

The working team composed of all project partners, following the input of University of Florence, lead beneficiary of this WP, defined common lines during an online meeting that took place on the 16<sup>th</sup> January 2023.

The 6 groups of young people (Bologna-Modena; Florence, Naples; Braga; Figueira da Foz and Krakow) focused on:

- carrying on the action-research activites: reflecting and re-elaborating the historical contents collected in relation to the holocaust and the history of Roma people;
- thinking about a project proposal (educational and engaging) for a wider target group of youngsters (groups of adolescents Roma and not Roma).
- analysing the documentation, choosing the materials to build the trama of artistic events and to implement website/webdoc (at least 2h training).

Training activities on how to catalogue and choose the material for each group, took place according to the table below:

The action research realized by the different groups, produced:

- an international bibliographical review with a series of abstracts of the main historical texts examined (realized by the Portuguese group);

- some online sources about Roma history;

- a bibliography of useful materials (books, sites, open access resources...) in Italian;


- a historical overview of Roma history produced by the Polish group;

Moreover, in order to spread and give visibility to material and resources collected by the different groups, the University of Bologna is creating a multimedia documentary (webdoc)

that will be set up during there months and connected to the project website (<u>https://www.tracerproject.eu/</u>).

The Webdoc area will include various multimedia materials (video clips, photos, documents, etc.) that will be catalogued according to four categories: Research, History, Reflection, Arts. In each area, it will be possible to read/view the materials and the activity done by each partner and by each group of young people.
